
**REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS
AND SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION INFO.**

REQUIREMENT: Must be baptized Catholic and have received the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Communion.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION:

Confirmation is considered a sacrament of initiation which means it brings us into deeper communion with the Church.

As parents, your participation in the Confirmation program and your child's ongoing faith formation is vital. Your prayer life and attitude towards Jesus Christ and His Church is the best example your child can have.

In order to allow for greater flexibility, time management and conflicting commitments, parents are being asked to join a free online email program called **Decision Point**, from Dynamic Catholic:

It gives parents the tools they need to prepare and engage their child in a meaningful conversation about Catholicism and the Sacrament of Confirmation. Topics include decision making, relationships, prayer and finding your purpose. This is a wonderful opportunity to join your child on this life-changing journey and to nurture your own spiritual journey as well.

IMPORTANT DATES: Please take note of the important dates below. We ask that you make every effort to attend these.

RITE OF ENROLMENT LITURGY: At all weekend Masses on Feb. 22nd/23rd, 2025, that is either at the 4:30 p.m. Mass, Saturday, Feb. 22nd, the 9:00 a.m. Mass, Sunday, Feb. 23rd, or the 10:30 a.m. Mass, Sunday, Feb. 23rd.

CONFIRMATION RETREAT: Saturday, May 3rd, 2025, from 10:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon in the parish hall (tentative).

DATE OF CONFIRMATION: Late May, to be determined.

Please note: your child will require a sponsor (godparent) for his/her confirmation. The sponsor must be 16 years of age or older and must be Catholic.
